

Gas Fireplace

Instructions

NOTE: This is a "Majestic" Fireplace, but type is unknown



The Flame Igniter and Rocker Switch are located under the fireplace at the far left. The Pilot Control and Flame Control knobs are easily located as part of the gas control mechanism. The Remote Receiver lies loose at the left side with wires connected to the back of the Rocker Switch.



Remote Receiver


Rocker Switch

The Rocker Switch has three positions.

The "ON" position (press the top part of the switch) turns the fire on.

The "RS" position (press the bottom part of the switch) permits the remote control switch to turn the fire on and off.

The neutral position (halfway between "ON" and "RS") turns the fire off.




Remote Receiver

The Remote Receiver has three positions. NOTE: the Rocker Switch must be in the "RS" Positon for the Remote to work.


The "On" position (Move switch button all the way to the right) turns the fire on.


The "Off" position (move switch button to the midde) turns the fire off.

The "Remote" position (move switch button all the way to the left) permits the fire to be operated using the remote control.

To Light the Pilot

Put the Rocker Switch in the "Neutral" Position.

Turn on the main gas line (located to the left of the fireplace on the floor) by turning the key counterclockwise.

Turn the Pilot Control to "Pilot".

Push the Pilot Control knob in.

While holding the Pilot Control knob in, depress the Flame Igniter until the pilot lights. Keep holding the Pilot Control knob in for about a minute. *NOTE: the pilot flame will be visible on the left side of the grate area looking down between the logs.*

Slowly let the Pilot Control knob out until it can be turned counterclockwise to the "ON" position.

Now set the Rocker Switch to "RS" and the Remote Receiver to "Remote" if Remote Control operation is desired.
